

# The project « From War History To Modern Education » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

### Five events have been carried out within this project:

#### **Event 1**

**Participation:** The event involved 78 citizens, including 52 participants from the city of Rautjärvi (**Finland**), 26 participants from the city of Ruokolahti (**Finland**)

Location / Dates: The event took place in Rautjärvi (Finland), from 20/10/2015 to 20/10/2015

**Short description:** The aim of the event was to arrange first public hearing in Rautjärvi. We started looking for people to be interviewed.

#### **Event 2**

Participation: The event involved 62 citizens, including 22 participants from the city of Tartu (Estonia), 40 participants from the region of Saaremaa (Estonia.)

**Location / Dates:** The events took place in Tartu and Saaremaa region from 19/10/2015 to 31/10/2015. **Short description:** The aim of the event was to arrange first public hearings in Estonia. We started looking for people to be interviewed.

#### **Event 3**

**Participation:** The event involved 640 citizens, including 510 participants from the city of Rautjärvi and Imatra (**Finland**), 48 participants from the city of Tartu (**Estonia**) and 82 participants from the city of Hobro (**Denmark**) **Location / Dates:** The event took place in Finland, Estonia and Denmark, from 01/09/2016 to 31/11/2016 **Short description:** The aim of the event was to test read the comic book with children and get their opinion. To do this we splited the children in smaller groups and got them to discuss about it. After this each group stated their common opinion and wrote it down. We also tested the role-playing game and got children and teachers opinions from it. To test role playing game we planned the situation with teachers so the test situation could be like any other class situation. We wanted to ensure that the experience was enjoyable for children.

#### Event 4

**Participation:** The event involved 34 citizens, including 31 participants from the city of Tartu (**Estonia**) and 3 participants from Finland.

Location / Dates: The events took place in Tartu (Estonia) from 08/06/2016 to 08/06/2016.

**Short description:** Research seminar on Tartu university. We published the research report and presented the findings.

## Event 5

**Participation:** The event involved 89 citizens, including 87 participants from Finland and 2 participants from Russia.

Location / Dates: The events took place in Rautjärvi (Finland) from 17/11/2016 to 17/11/2016.

**Short description:** Final seminar on Rautjärvi. We promoted the project and its findings. We also presented all the learning tools and discussed about the future of these kind of methods.
